

An overview of the Southern Corridor Improvements

- ✓ Improved journey reliability on the Southern Motorway
- ✓ More lanes to improve traffic flow
- ✓ Upgraded Takanini Interchange to improve safety and traffic flow
- ✓ Improved connections between the local roads and state highway network to ease congestion
- ✓ Better connections for freight and public transport
- ✓ Improved walking and cycling facilities to connect communities



What we've achieved since last forum

- New Takanini northbound merge lane opening 11 February. Dedicated merge lane onto SH1 will ease congestion for motorists heading north.
- Puhinui stream walkway upgrade completed and open for pedestrian access between Lawrence Crescent and Botanical Gardens.
- Northbound on-ramp works include Great South Road bridges.
- Pahurehure Inlet bridge reconstruction works continue with demolition of existing lanes to make way for new southbound lanes.
- 82% of noise walls have been put in to improve effects on neighbouring residents.
- Retaining wall and stormwater infrastructure alongside the Botanical Gardens.
- · Project completion date on track for the North, Central and South areas.








