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Methodology

- Historic crash data along the Golden Mile
 - Crash type
 - Crash Cause
 - User
 - Vehicle
- Route Knowledge and Focus Areas
 - 2010 Golden Mile Bus Route Changes (and subsequent safety studies)
 - WCC Institutional Knowledge
 - Focus area Manners Street, Willis Street to Victoria Street
 - 'Jaywalking'













Methodology

- Prediction Models
 - Relevance
- Used historic crash data to extrapolate expected crash profiles
- · Considered users pedestrians, cyclists, buses & 'other'
- · Compared proposed changes to current environment & crash history
- Used experienced practitioner judgement













• Future crashes will follow the same pattern as historic chashes.
