Information Request – Communications with Police regarding strike action

I refer to your official information request dated 29 August 2022 asking for the following information:

Please provide all written correspondence between Fire and Emergency and New Zealand Police regarding the taking of 111 during the NZPFU strike action.

Please also include any internal emails involving the communication centre managers referring to the New Zealand Police taking 111 calls on behalf of Fire and Emergency New Zealand.

The Official Information Act 1982 (**OIA**) requires that we advise you of our decision on your request no later than 20 working days after the day we received your request. Unfortunately, it will not be possible to meet that time limit and we are writing to notify you of an extension of time to make our decision, to 25 October 2022.

The extension is required as you have asked for information relating to emergency call taking procedures, including communications with another agency. The information in scope of your request necessitates consultations in order to make a decision to provide that information.
