# Official information request – Removal of graffiti at Waitangi Park

Thank you for your request made under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (the Act), received on 15 November 2023. You requested the following information:

- I am writing to inquire about the decision to remove the Palestinian graffiti at the dedicated graffiti areas at Waitangi skate park. I am interested in understanding the information related to this decision. Specifically, I would like to request the following:
- 1. A comprehensive list of all individuals or groups consulted in the process of making the decision to remove the graffiti.
- 2. Any correspondence, memos, or documents related to the decision to remove the graffiti.
- 3. Information about any collaborations with external parties regarding the decision to remove the graffiti.
- 4. A list of policies related to when graffiti must be removed and if graffiti has been removed in the past and for what reasons.

The decision to remove graffiti (or not) rests with Wellington City Council. Recent political messaging at Waitangi Park was removed by Wellington Waterfront and City Parks team of Wellington City Council, as it has been in other parts of the city. Wellington City Council contracts responsibility for removal of this unauthorised signage to other parties rather than undertaking it directly.

Wellington City Council has **granted** your request for 'Any correspondence, memos, or documents related to the decision to remove the graffiti'. Below are the documents that fall in scope of this part of your request and my decision to release the document. Any consultations or collaborations that occurred about the decision to remove the graffiti is provided within the body of this documentation and correspondence.

Please note that information has been withheld from these documents under the following sections of the Act:

- Section 7(2)(a) to protect the privacy of individuals.
- Section 7(2)(f)(i) to maintain the effective conduct of public affairs through the free and frank expression of opinions by or between or to members or officers or employees.

Information withheld under section 7(2)(a) are names, email addresses and/or telephone numbers. Emails withheld under section 7(2)(f)(i) are those arriving at the appropriate wording of public communications associated with graffiti removal. Some communications have also been withheld as they are not within the scope of your information request – these are administrative in nature and are not associated with the decision to remove the graffiti.

You have also asked to be provided with a list of policies related to when graffiti must be removed and if graffiti has been removed in the past and for what reasons. The council routinely removes graffiti from its assets and from public places. Any graffiti considered to be offensive is removed with greater urgency. More detail of our rules and policies relating to signage, posters etc in public spaces and graffiti are available from our website, such as on the following links:




