We have received the transfer of your request from the Ministry of Health on 28 October 2015 under the Official Information Act 1982, regarding car parking at Hutt District Health Board (HVDHB).

1. Do you obtain any revenue directly or indirectly from car parking charges?

Yes, HVDHB does obtain revenue from car parking charges.

2. When did you begin receiving any such revenue?

Paid car parking started in 1993 and was originally managed by Wilson's car parking. Since 2009/2010 the car parking has been managed by the HVDHB.

3. The amount of money received each year in car parking charges?

Parking Revenue	\$258,079	\$732,842	\$736,358	\$981,727	\$1,013,801	\$979,145


4. If charges are just levied against members of the public and/or if staff are expected to pay too?

Both public and staff are required to pay to use the parking on campus.

5. Are there any exemptions or limits to the charges imposed at the site?

Exemptions are for Police, Department of Corrections staff, and fleet cars. Parents of children in our Paediatric Ward are not charged.
