We hope your preparations for SCOPE and initial PAT are going well.

The pre police college distance learning course is a key component to the police selection process, usually starting after interview. However we'd like to take this opportunity to see if you would like to enrol early. [Check out dates we are running the course here.](#)

The course will run alongside the remainder of your selection process including SCOPE, interview and reference checks.

The 12-week long course will require part-time study for approximately 12-15 hours per week. Please note you must be able to commit to the workload consistently, for each and every week of the course.

Please note: If you do not meet the required standards of any of the remaining steps in the selection process, your application may be declined. If your application is declined, you will not be reimbursed for the cost of the distance learning course.

Course Cost: \$715 (non-refundable) payment will be due during the enrolment period prior to the course start date.

If you are not ready to enrol in Distance Learning at this stage, you do not need to reply to this email. You will be offered the opportunity to enrol in future cohorts.
