Generally they are all good but can you please make the small changes indicated on the attached plan "Changes". i.e:

- 1) Please adjust the ramps to align along the street as indicated. I also include a copy of our standard pedestrian ramp with suggestion it be narrowed to 1200mm to make it practical in this corner situation.
- 2) Remove the flexible bollards in WCC street. These are not considered necessary.
- 3) Remove the words "Vehicle Crossing" (Our reason for removing is because this not an approved vehicle crossing, since it has street sumps in the kerb plus wheel stops in the pavement. If the school wishes to occasionally use it for access they will need to place timbers in the channel and around the wheel stop and only for the duration the vehicle is accessing or leaving the site. If that is not acceptable and a more common vehicle access is needed then the whole design needs to change with the removal of one of the sumps, regrading of the street channel and removal of the wheel stops.)

I understand from Matts comments that you consider the vehicle turning area needs to slope back towards the school due to school level needs.

I attach an adjusted copy of the perspective view you provided with some adjustments I would like made for it be acceptable. I understand you wanted some wheel stops to protect the bollards which are on school land adjoining the turning area.

I attach a plan previously shared which includes those wheel stops.

I also attach a cross-section to show the road pavement in the turning area to accommodate the wheel stop and transition construction to the adjoining asphalt carriageway.

Please progress in providing an updated quotation for the work quoted below on the plan attached.

To recap, Chorus has provided a quotation to the Ministry of Education for the termination/relocation of services in part of Turnbull Street. This is to facilitate a land swap, whereby the Wellington City Council swap land with the Ministry of Education. The Council land being acquired by the Ministry is 141sqm, currently road, adjacent to 19 and 21 Turnbull Street. The Ministry has agreed to pay any relocation/termination costs for services that existing in the road they are looking to acquire.

It seems that part of infrastructure belonging to Chorus was overlooked when we requested the attached quote. We also need the relocation/termination of the cable and post that runs form BS51/11 WN465 to BS51/9 WN465 shown on the proposed design at 21 Turnbull Street. 


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

The following is a bullet point summary of the main discussion points:

Deb gave some background: The Ministry of Education (the Ministry) is wanting to stop a

- part of Turnbull Street. There is an existing hydrant and piping to service an emergency water supply within the part of the road the Ministry wishes to be stopped.
- The Ministry are wanting to relocate the existing hydrant so it remains in the public road reserve and relocate the emergency water supply piping.
- The emergency water supply is currently located on Ministry land, facilitated by way of a lease.
- The Ministry requires written approval from Wellington Water (WW) that is agreeable to this relocation.
- Ben mentioned that in principle, it appears that this could be acceptable, as long as:
  - o The relocated hydrant is at least 2 metres from the "new" road termination point;
  - o Scouring (and other required servicing/maintenance activities) of the water main in Turnbull Street can continue to occur; and
  - o The piping to service the emergency water supply does not cross over the sewer line
- Deb commented that there was no formal easement at present in place for the emergency water supply piping, and as such the Ministry would want this to remain the case for the relocation of the piping.
- Deb explained that the Ministry would be extremely reluctant to grant an easement to WW over this specific school land due to its duty of care for the students. Deb also mentioned section 78CA of the Education Act that deals with police vetting of contractors and how the granting of an easement over this specific piece of Ministry land could be in direct conflict with this clause.
- Ben will review the information and consult with others where necessary and respond to Deb and Matt.
- Deb mentioned the critical timing issues and asked if a response could be provided by COB Wednesday 28 March.

Ben, I hope that captures the main discussion points. Please feel free to add any further points (or amend where you feel I have not represented things correctly) and send back to both Matt and I.
