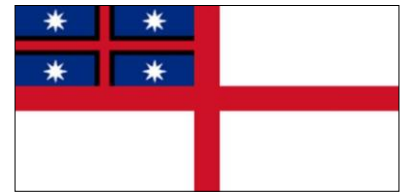

NOTICE OF CEASE AND DESIST

In the matter of Nu Tirenī with respect to the 35 –year Resource Consent for Waikato Region-Wide Aerial drops of 1080 Poison into the Environment by TB Free NZ/OSPRI Ltd, Department o Conservation/Waikato Regional Council/.

Let it be known that this is the Third Notice of Cease and Desist dated 30 May, 2016

Let it be known that on this 29th day of the month of March in the year 2015 that we of Te Hapu o Te Wakaminegna Wahi o Maniapoto o Nu Tireni having publicly Proclaimed Our Right of Self Determination, Our Sovereignty and Our enactment of the internationally recognised He wakaputanga o te Rangatiratanga o Nu Tireni of 1835 and Te Tiriti o Waitangi of 1840 having gathered together in our collective capacity as Hapu exercising Our Hapu Kawa Tikanga have discussed in detail the matter raised and made the following determination:

That the Tupuna Whenua, ManaTaimoana, Mana Wai, Mana Waipapa, and Taonga Toku Iho described in this matter is Tupuna Whenua of the above Proclaimed Hapu of Ngati Maniapoto and Nga Hapu o Nu Tireni any and all resources within said area are under the absolute authority of said Hapu. Hence it is our will and intent to continue to occupy our Tupuna Whenua and utilise its resources as we see fit, as is our ancestral right, our customary right, our inherent right and our birth right in accordance with our Hapu Kawa Tikanga and the internationally recognised He wakaputanga o te Rangatiratanga o Nu Tireni of 1835, and protected by the internationally recognised Te Tiriti o Waitangi of 1840.

Therefore the said land and its resources are ***not to be poisoned by aerial drops of 1080 or other poisons and*** other activities without the express written permission of we the Proclaimed Hapu, as we the Proclaimed Hapu hold Absolute Authority of the said land and all its resources .

If the Ministry for the Environment, Department of Conservation, Waikato Regional Council, OSPRI New Zealand Ltd, or TB Free New Zealand Ltd and their agents and principals continues to proceed with this matter We NOTICE the Ministry for the Environment, Department of Conservation, Waikato Regional Council, OSPRI New Zealand Ltd, or TB Free New Zealand Ltd and their agents and principals continues that:

It is an undisputed fact that there has been no lawful rebuttal to an exacting point of law of Te Hapu o Te Wakaminenga Wahi o Maniapoto o Nu Tireni Public Proclamation of Self Determination, Sovereignty and enactment of He wakaputanga o te Rangatiratanga o Nu Tireni of 1835. Thus it prevails in truth and law.

It is an undisputed fact that Te Hapu o Te Wakaminegna Wahi o Maniapoto o Nu Tireni whilst enacting He wakaputanga o te Rangatiratanga o Nu Tireni of 1835 and exercising Our Hapu Kawa Tikanga hold absolute authority over all Our territory, Our Tupuna Whenua, and all that it encompasses.

It is an undisputed fact that our Rights are Internationally recognised.

It is an undisputed fact that Our Rights are also protected through the enactment in New Zealand statute of Section 28 of the 1990 NZ Bill of Rights Act, which Binds the Crown.

It is an undisputed fact that the **Ministry for the Environment, Department of Conservation, Waikato Regional Council, OSPRI New Zealand Ltd, or TB Free New Zealand Ltd and their agents and principals** has produced no internationally recognised documented lawful authority substantiating the **Ministry for the Environment, Department of Conservation, Waikato Regional Council, OSPRI New Zealand Ltd, or TB Free New Zealand Ltd and their agents and principals** claim to the land or other taonga. Until such claim is substantiated to an exacting point of law the **Ministry for the Environment, Department of Conservation, Waikato Regional Council, OSPRI New Zealand Ltd, or TB Free New Zealand Ltd and their agents and principals** is bereft of any credibility as to its lawful standing in this matter and is not in a lawful position to negotiate or conduct any transaction pertaining to the said land or taonga. To continue to do so will be seen as a fraudulent act and thus a criminal offence.

It is an undisputed fact that any party present upon the said land or taonga without the live signed authority of the Proclaimed Hapu is acting in trespass and potential invasion and breaching Our Hapu Kawa Tikanga.

It is an undisputed fact that only Queen Elizabeth II herself is able to purchase land, and only land that has been agreed to be sold by Congress of Nga Hapu. To do otherwise is a trespass of jurisdiction and breach of international agreement.



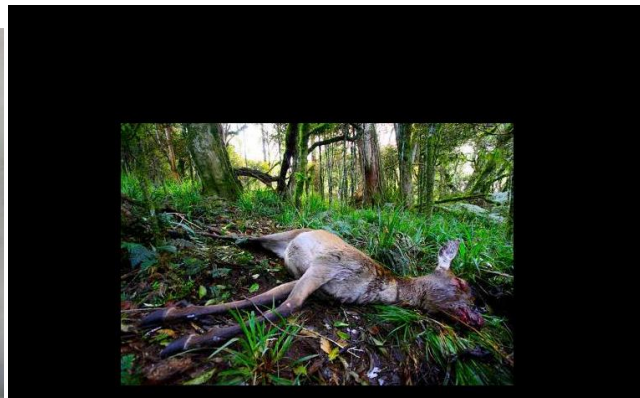
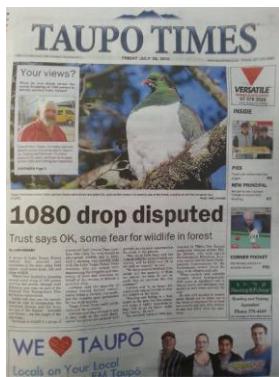

9.2.5 Turangi incident (1995)

Young girl was poisoned when she ate 1080 pellets that ended up in her parents back section/garden after a 1080 poison over-fly. It is important to realise, that had baits with the loadings of .15%w.w. 1080 as are used today by DoC, been consumed by the child, it is likely the episode would have been tragically fatal. The baits at that time were generally .06% w.w. 1080 or .08%w.w. 1080 maximum.

Major alert after child chews possum poison

IT took parental first aid, a doctor, two hospitals, two ambulances, the National Poisons centre and a 190 km drive to get medical treatment when 15-month-old Natalie Albert ate 1080-laced cereal bait on Labour Day.

Nobody seemed to know what to do when Blanche Turner and her family found the baby chewing on green 1080 bait in a Maori cemetery at Otukou, near Rotoaira Forest, at the foot of Mount Tongariro.

The 1080 bait was airdropped by helicopter, under contract to Environment Waikato on October 17/18.

The Turner family and friends were cleaning up the Otukou graveyard, 130m from the nearest marae house, when they found baby Natalie chewing on a 1080 pellet.

They shoved their fingers down Natalie's throat to make her sick, rang Turangi ambulance, and drove to the main highway to meet it, then worked to keep a very upset increasingly drowsy child awake through-

out the 25 minute, 30 km drive.

At Turangi Medical Centre a doctor administered an emetic, which produced more green cereal in the vomit, and had her rushed by ambulance to Taupo Hospital 50km north.

At Taupo she was administered charcoal to absorb any poison in the gut and sent on another 80km ambulance trip to Rotorua Hospital where treatment staff were awaiting a fax from the National Poisons Centre, Dunedin for further treatment advice.

However, the emetics seemed to have done the trick and Natalie was discharged after a night's observation and follow-up tests. But Mrs Turner is critical of the apparent lack of knowledge by local medical authorities in a 1080 emergency considering the amount of poison being showered over the region, and the dropping of pellets so close to the village.

She was still picking up 1080 pellets

around the marae on October 31.

"There's no way we can find them all. We've been down every day picking them up. There are even pellets in the paddock behind the Otukou school."

National Poison Centre information officer Dr Richard Mason said the centre has had 75 inquiry calls on 1080 over the past year of which 10 related to human exposure and 16 to animal poisoning. The balance were for general information or suspect exposure which did not prove to be actual poisoning.

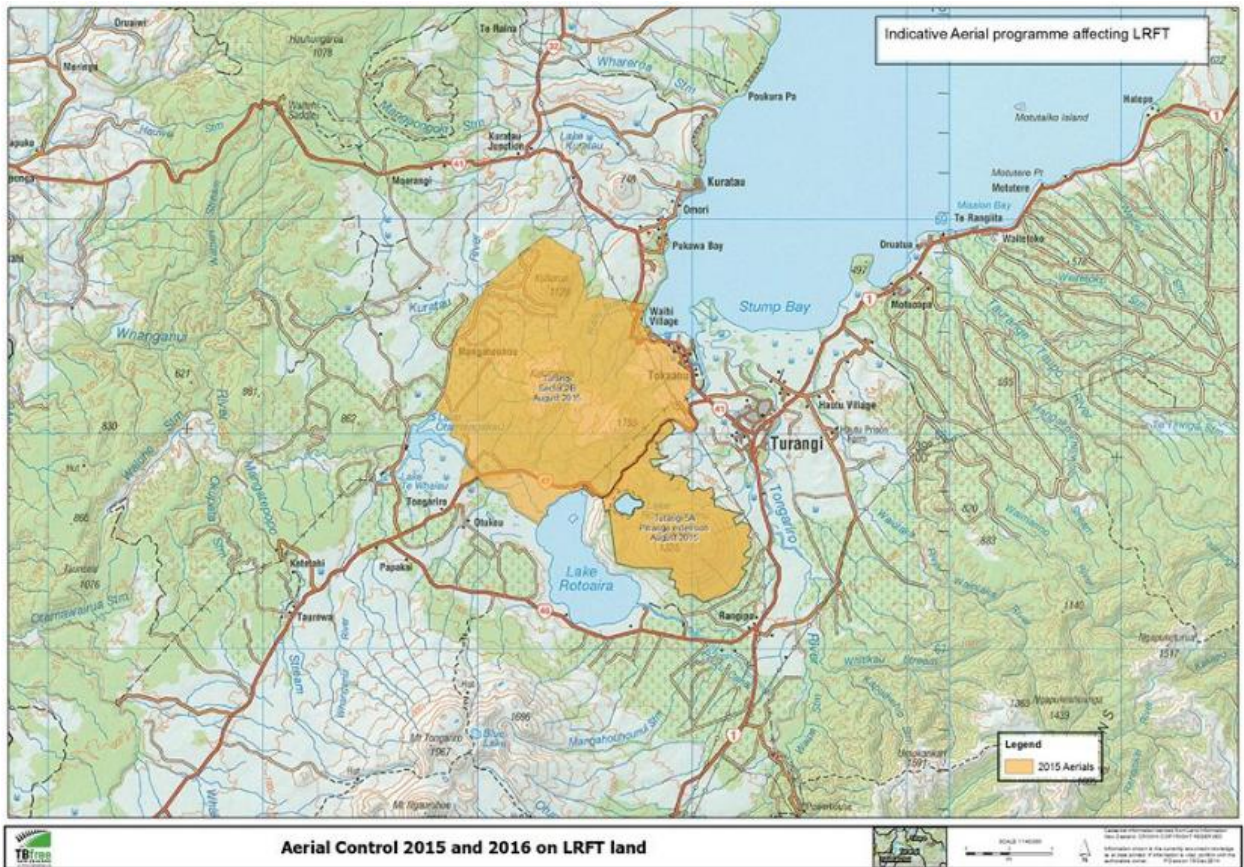
Environment Waikato's group manager for biosecurity, John Simmonds, said there had been some opposition by Rotoaira locals to the aerial operation and it had been modified to allow some ground hunting.

But there was no opposition to aerial dropping on the cemetery which was unmarked.

The drop was part of a major operation on Rotoaira Forest and part of Tongariro National Park.

We the People of Te Hapu o te Wakaminenga wahi o Maniapoto exercising our ancient Right stemming from time immemorial do hereby with One Voice and Consent of Tongue and Heart Publish and Proclaim our Self-determination, our Intrinsic Sovereignty, and our Honouring and Enactment of the internationally recognised Proclamation He wakaputanga o te Rangatiratanga o Nu Tireni 1835, and the internationally recognised Standing Agreement of the Parties Te Tiriti o Waitangi 1840. And We do solemnly in the presence of the Creator profess, testify, and declare that We do make this Proclamation, and every part thereof, in the plain and ordinary sense of the words as they are commonly understood by the Native People.

By the passing of our Ancestors We are called to assume and fulfil the duties and responsibilities of our Inherent Sovereignty. Thus We the people of Te Hapu o te Wakaminenga wahi o Maniapoto O Nu Tireni Lawfully Constituted to internationally recognised He wakaputanga o te Rangatiratanga o Nu Tireni 1835, with full acknowledgement and agreement between Her Honourable Majesty Queen Elizabeth II and Nga Rangatira o Nga Hapu o Nu Tireni, and exercising our self-determination through our Hapu Kawa Tikanga our ancient Right and customary usages, do hereby Publically Proclaim our Absolute Sovereignty over our Lives and Property. Whereas ignorance of fact and law by some has become a disregard and contempt for the Intrinsic Unalienable Absolute Human Right of all men and women to Self-determination; and,

Whereas this ignorance perpetuates the ongoing enslavement and oppression of members of the Human Family; and,

Whereas recognition that to exercise Self-determination, the unfettered peaceful expression of ones will, and to form associations to live together in peace and harmony and in Honour of all things, is the Absolute Right of all men and women; and,

Whereas, being Men and Women of Sovereign State, it is our responsibility and obligation to strive to create a world in which all men, women and children shall enjoy freedom of expression, freedom from fear and deprivation, and freedom from enslavement, and that Peace and Good Order is maintained for the betterment of all that dwell within our Territory.

Therefore it is the duty and responsibility of We the People as True Native Sovereigns to insure that the Constitutional Order and Rule of Law of our Territory of Nu Tireni is Honoured, and that the agreement granting the privilege of governance to Queen Victoria is Lawfully administered and upheld in the fullness of its intent and entirety.

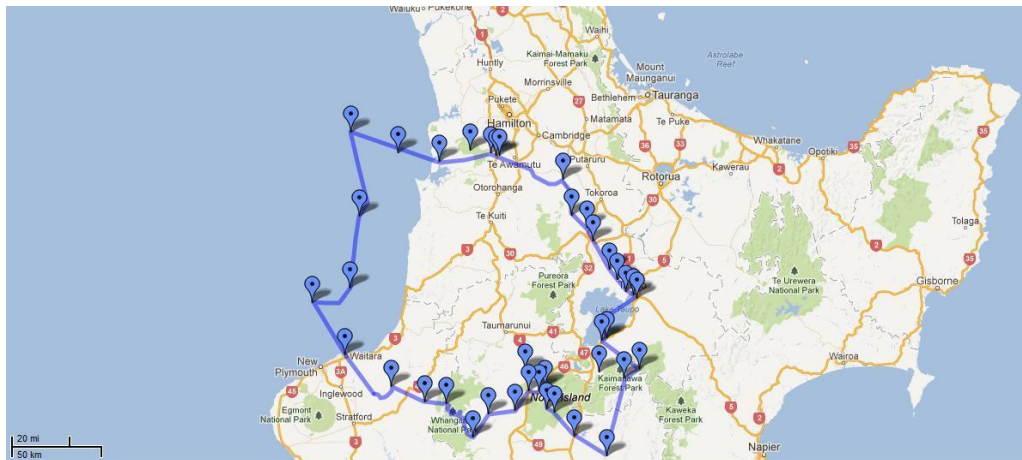
