The Ministry's current job listings change regularly, so you might find it helpful to set up an email alert for vacancies matching your search. To do this, create a search for jobs in the Waikato or Hamilton areas and select the 'create alert' button. You are also able to specify how often you wish to receive alerts. This will prompt you to join the Ministry's Talent Community.
