Official Information Act request ChChD (Canterbury District) 10899

I refer to your email dated 7 June 2022 to Ministry of Health which they subsequently transferred to us on 15th June 2022. Your request asks for the following information under the Official Information Act from **Waitaha Canterbury** regarding outsourcing elective surgeries. Specifically:

- 1. The total number of surgeries outsourced by year (including the year to date) for the past five years.
- 2. For each year, provide a breakdown of the type of procedure.

Please refer to **Table one** (below) for approximate elective outsourced surgeries provided in Waitaha Canterbury, This information is from 1 January 2018 to 31 March 2022 noting for 2022 three months of information is provided.
