I would like this information in writing (electronically / email / word doc or PDF is preferred so as not to waste money on postage).

If there is any information you hold on the decision process that was carried out in order to justify this upgrade, I would like this or at least be pointed to the department responsible for this so I can request it of them.

I would like details cost of the project that I assume was performed in order to come to the decision to upgrade the executive suite. As I do not know what the project was called I ask your patience with my request and for your honesty in investigating this for me."

Your request was received by the Treasury on 12 May 2017 and will be dealt with in accordance with the provisions of the Official Information Act.
