“A formal request to receive a patient from Fiji for treatment in New Zealand has been declined on clinical grounds. A planned transfer of a patient with COVID-19 requiring hospital level care has been declined following advice from the Intensive Care Unit directors of the three Auckland metro DHBs that given other commitments there is not sufficient capacity to currently take the patient.

“The decision has been communicated to the appropriate Fijian authorities.”
