Official Information Act request

On the 24 August 2022 Te Puni Kōkiri received a transfer for your Official Information Act request from the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet. Your request was for:

"All documents and Cabinet papers mentioning Whangārei in relation to infrastructure and health funding decisions from the date beginning October 2017."

Your request has been considered in accordance with the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act).

The Cabinet Office initially identified two documents that may have been within scope of your request.
