Dear T Murray,

Thank you for your email on 18 December in which you request the following under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA):

"Could you please provide the cost of the Minister and accompanying staff to attend COP28 summit in Dubai. Please advise the names of staff / department representatives and their position traveling with the Minister. Expenditure should include and be broken down by type of expenditure such as meals, hotels, flights, taxis."

On 20 December 2024, the scope of your request was clarified that your request for information excluded staff from departmental agencies who are travelling separately to support COP28 negotiations. On 12 January 2024, the time limits for responding to your request were extended by an additional 10 working days because the consultations necessary to make a decision on your request are such that a proper response couldn't reasonably be made within the original time frame (section 15A(1)(b) of the OIA refers).

Appendix 1 outlines information regarding travel costs associated with my travel to the 29th United Nations Climate Change Conference in Dubai (COP28). As requested by you, expenditure is broken down by type of expenditure.
