Dear Suze,

I write to respond to your request dated 11 April 2024 requesting the following information under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

Could you please tell me the cost of:

- a. setting up and operating the independent expert panel to review the methane targets, and,
- b. the annual cost of operating the Climate Change Commission.

The Methane Science and Target Review's independent expert panel is intended to be set up as a Ministerial Advisory Group. The costs of setting up and operating the Advisory Group have not yet been finalised. The remuneration for all Advisory Group appointments will be based on the Cabinet Fees Framework. Therefore, I am refusing the first part of your request under section 18(g) of the Act, as no information requested is held and I have no grounds to believe it is held by another agency.

The annual cost of operating the Climate Change Commission (the Commission) is contained in its Annual Reports. The Commission's forecast financial statements for 2023/24 are contained in its 2023/24 Statement of Performance Expectations. Therefore, I am refusing the second part of your request under section 18(d) of the Act, as the information requested is publicly available.
