Dear Peter

I refer to your Official Information Act request of 20 October 2015 for information about the Drager 7510NZ evidential breath test (EBT) devices.

You requested:

*I would like any advice, briefings and internal memos that informed decision making to rollout the evidential Drager 7510 device for the period 1 January 2012 to 1 October 2015. I would particularly like any briefings provided to the Minister of Police, Commissioner of Police, Assistant Commissioner for Road Safety and the national manager of road policing that informed the use of the 7510 devices.*

I am able to provide copies of the following documents in response to this part of your request:

- *BR/14/60MW Briefing for the Minister of Police – Approval of New Drager 7510NZ Evidential Breath Testing Device*

*... information on analysis that informed the use of the device and the requirements for overseeing the accuracy and calibration of the devices.*

I have attached a copies of the following documents for your information:

- *Request for Proposal (NZ Police as Purchaser) – Handheld Evidential Breath Alcohol Testing Devices*
- *Technical Testing of Drager 7510NZ Breath Testing Device report*

The *Request for Proposal* document was produced by Police in the procurement of EBT devices and outlines the accuracy specifics that they were required to meet.

The *Technical Testing* report provides a summary of the initial testing conducted by Police on the EBT devices.

Some information has been redacted from the document provided pursuant to section 9(2)(a) of the Official Information Act 1982 in order to protect the privacy of natural persons.
